SHADE TREES

Red Maple – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall @ purchase) = \$199; 2” caliper (12’) = \$249; 2.5” (14’) caliper = \$309

Autumn Blaze Maple (50’ x 40’ @ maturity) – Orange / Red in fall

Brandywine Maple (40’ x 30’) – Scarlet in fall

October Glory Maple (40’ x 40’) – Orange / Red in fall

‘Purple Leafed’ Maple – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall @ purchase) = \$219; 2” caliper (12’) = \$269

Crimson Sunset Maple (35’ x 25’ @ maturity) – Purple / Red in fall

Sugar Maple – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall @ purchase) = \$219; 2” caliper (12’) = \$269

Green Mountain Sugar Maple (70’ x 45’ @ maturity) – Yellow / Orange in fall

Birch – 6’-8’ multi-stem @ purchase = \$145

River Birch (45’ x 45’) – Yellow in fall

Thornless Honey locust – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall) = \$199, 2” caliper (12’ tall) = \$249

Skyline Locust (45’ x 35’) – Yellow in fall

Sweetgum – 2” caliper (12’ tall) = \$269

American Sweetgum (60’ x 40’) – Gold / Maroon in fall

‘Rotundiloba’ Fruitless Sweetgum (75’ x 40’) – Deep Purple in fall

Tulip – 1.5” caliper (8-10’ tall) = \$189

Tulip Tree (60’ x 40’) – Yellow in fall

Sycamore – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall) = \$199, 2” caliper (12’ tall) = \$249

‘Exclamation’ London Plane Tree (60’ x 30’) – Yellow in fall

Oak – 1.5” caliper (8-10’ tall) = \$189; 1.75” (10’) = \$219; 2” (12’) = \$269

Chinkapin Oak (50’ x 50’) – Yellow in fall

Bur Oak (70’ x 70’) – Yellow in fall

Northern Red Oak (60’x 60’) – Red in fall

Scarlet Oak (70’ x 40’) – Scarlet in fall

Swamp White Oak (45’ x 45’) – Yellow in fall

Elm – 1.75” caliper (10’ tall) = \$199; 2” caliper (12’) = \$249

Frontier Elm (40’ x 30’) – Reddish / Purple in fall

Princeton Elm (65’ x 50’) – Yellow in fall

Triumph Elm (55’ x 45’) – Yellow in fall

FLOWERING TREES

Cherry – 2” caliper (10’ tall) = \$229

Kwanzan Cherry (30’ x 20’) – Double rosy, pink flowers, red fall color

Canada Red Chokecherry (25’ x 20’) – White flowers, leaves emerge green then turn purple

Crabapple – 2” caliper (8-10’ tall) = \$209

Prairiefire Crabapple (20’ x 15’) – Dark pink flower in spring, foliage is reddish green in summer

Royal Raindrops (20’ x 15’) – Bright pink flower in spring, foliage is purplish green in summer

Dogwood – 1.5” caliper = \$189; 1.75” caliper = \$229

Kousa Dogwood (20’ x 20’) – white flowers in spring, red fall color

Hydrangea – #15 = \$199

Limelight Hydrangea (6’-8’ x 5’-7’) – large, lime green flowers turning pink

Magnolia – 5' Clump = \$199; 6' Clump = \$249

Susan Magnolia (8' x 8') – pink flowers in spring, yellow fall color

Sweet Bay Magnolia (20' x 15') – white, cream flowers

Redbud – 1.5" caliper = \$179

Eastern Redbud (25' x 25') – pink flowers in spring, yellow fall color

Ruby Falls (8' x 6') – weeping form, purple leaves with rose spring blooms

Tree Lilac – 1.5" (8' tall) = \$229

Ivory Silk Tree Lilac (20' x 15') – White flowers in June, foliage is green in summer, yellow in fall

EVERGREENS

Juniper – 6' = \$309

Eastern Red Cedar (40' x 20') – Green foliage, bronze winter color, good for dry sites

Spruce – 4' = \$160; 5' = \$235; 6' = \$309

Norway Spruce – (50' x 30') – full sun to partial shade

Serbian Spruce – (50' x 30') – Shiny dark green needles that have white bands on lower surface

Black Hills Spruce – (50' x 20') – Grayish blue green branches

Pine – 4' = \$130; 5' = \$175; 6' = \$225

Eastern White Pine – (60' x 30') – Full sun to partial shade, bluish green, soft needles

Arborvitae – 5' = \$169; 6' = \$199

Emerald Green Arborvitae – (15' x 3') – Dense narrow, emerald, green needles

Green Giant Arborvitae – (50' x 20') – Dense, rich green needles
